Foot Warmer

Pine, ash, tin, iron

Description

A large rectangular foot warmer, comprised of a dark stained wood frame, with upper and lower slatted panels and turned corner posts. A soldered tin box fits within the frame. The sides, back, and top panels are ornamented

with pierced or punched motifs depicting geometric patterns. The front door panel is boldly punch inscribed with "PRESENTED BY / JAS PRICE TO THE / REV S. C. HENRY / JAN. 1 1840," and closes with a simple shaped wire toggle loop handle. A sturdy iron bail handle is fastened to the top portion of the foot warmer frame. When opened, the door reveals a removable heavy sheet iron rectangular basket with a rolled tab pull to hold hot coals.
