### Description

A historic scene of the morning after the Battle of Monmouth, which occurred on 28 June 1778. George

Washington appears in the center of the canvas on a white horse. To the left of Washington is Baron von Steuben. The two officers behind Washington may be Marquis de Lafayette and Alexander Hamilton. General Greene stands before Washington and von Steuben presenting Molly Pitcher to the General. She is dressed in a red skirt and a Continental soldier's jacket. In the middle and distant backgrounds are numerous soldiers on foot and horseback. A cannon is depicted on the left margin, and another cannon in parts on the right along with a punctured drum. Weapons are spread on the ground in the foreground, and the sunrise sky is filled with smoke.
