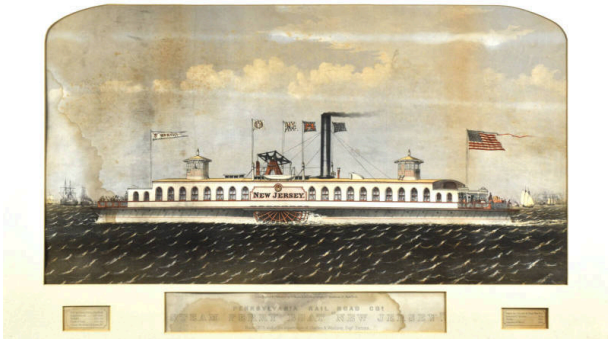

Description

A side view of a double-ended, side paddle wheel steamboat named "New Jersey," shown under way on water with a slight chop traveling from right to left.
