Description

A circular bronze medal with the image of Marshal Ferdinand Foch on the obverse, with the inscription "COMMEMORATING THE VISIT OF MARSHAL FOCH TO THE UNITED STATES / MCHXXI ANS." A small oak leaf cluster

can be seen above Foch's proper left shoulder. On the reverse, the figure of Victory holds a circular shield in her arm with the Service Star of the American Forces. The coats of arms of both France and the United States set within shields are depicted to the left and right of Victory. Artist Robert Aitken's initial monogram "RA" is inscribed at the lower left edge. The number "82" is stamped along the medal's rim edge. The medal is accompanied by its original white and gilt cardboard storage box.
