



Slat Back Side Chair

Medium

Maple

Description

The maple frame includes five graduated and arched slats, back posts with turned ball finials double scored around their center point and with a nipple on the top, and cabriole or "crook" front legs that are chamfered on their front edge and end in squared feet. A robustly turned tripartite front stretcher features two scored balls separated by a reel, and conical ends. Two pairs of dowl-turned side stretchers and a single rear stretcher complete the basic chair frame. The rear posts end in an abrupt taper. The rush seat is protected by shaped casings on three sides which are finished with a narrow bead. The seat, which is original to the chair, was woven with tightly twisted rush in a checkered pattern of three strands over three strands.
